Membership Report, Second Vice President

In the absence of the second vice-president due to illness, the report was deferred until the November 16, 2022 meeting.

Guest Speaker: Dr. John O'Bannon, Vice-Chair, Virginia Board of Elections

Dr. O'Bannon began by stating, "Elections will be fair in Virginia this year."

He went on to explain that there are 133 'political entities' in Virginia, and that each has an Electoral Board, which is responsible for hiring their respective General Registrar.

Every January, one member of each Electoral Board changes.

The State Board of Elections now has 3 Republican members, and two Democrat members. It is their job to govern elections and provide guidance to the Va. Dept. of Elections.

Susan Beales is the current Commissioner of the Virginia Board of Elections. [Note: "She really Knows election law."]

He asked those present, "Do you believe the 2020 Election was stolen?," and then continued by explaining that the Virginia General Assembly [at the time with a Democratic majority] changed the rules mid-stream. The changes caused 65% of Absentee Ballots statewide to be counted by CAP. The 'steal' occurred because of the rules of election being changed midyear.

Dr. Bannon indicated that Governor Youngkin's legislative initiatives include photo i.d.

Emergency COVID rules are no longer required.

Attorney General Jason Myares supports Republican suggestions for clean voting.

HRWC member Fran Sadler asked Dr. O'Bannon about 1500 non-citizen voters in Loudon County. He responded by saying that cleaning up voter roles is a perennial problem. "We are driving the train now, not the Democrats." Voter registries are updated weekly now. Death records are reported and corrected. Dr. O'Bannon encouraged anyone who has concerns about any aspect of the process, to contact the State Board of Elections.

Dr. O'Bannon gave an excellent overview, and was most appreciated by those members in attendance.

Education Law. His intent is to serve his constituents. He represents Parental Rights, and Advocates a Parental Rights Bill. He helped de-regulate the Virginia Wine industry. "I will be a reformer to REDUCE regulations and put money back in citizens' hands."

## State Senator Ryan McDougal:

The mid-term elections are crucial. The 2023 Virgina General Assembly will reintroduce even better voter bills.
