Introduction of HRWC Featured Speaker: Cherie Kasch

HRWC Featured Speaker: Ken Nunnencamp – Executive Director of the Republican Party of Virginia. He and his wife are Hanover residents and expecting a child within a month. As of Sunday, Ken resigned as Executive Director of RPV and officially joined the Hanover GOP. Nicholas Profit is the Interim Director.

Ken discussed the following:

- The RNC has just released \$5 million to help our efforts in Virginia.
- Ken has excelled in Data Analytics at both the National level and for the Youngkin campaign.
- He employs these proven ideas:
 - Simple ideas win.
 - Go back to how money is spent, not how much.
 - How to talk to the right people; the people who are listening.
 - Only way to win is person to person.

Ken was asked how our local clubs' impact RPV. He noted there are 133 areas with 124 clubs. As of June, Candidate training teams will be available within 1.5 hours. There was general discussion about Redistricting.
